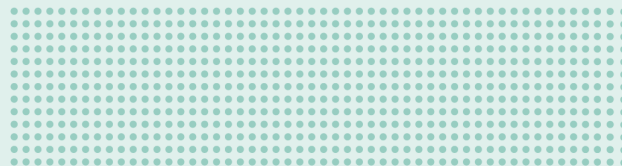
Would you make God's work here at Village a high priority in your Christmas gift giving this season?
