Day 1

Day 2

TODAY'S THEME: ALWAYS LOOK ON THE BRIGHT SIDE OF LIFE

Read Philippians 1: 12-13, 18

As Paul writes Philippians, he finds himself in a pretty tough situation. He is under house arrest in Rome for his teaching and defense of the gospel. It could have been easy for Paul to be upset about his imprisonment, especially because it wasn't "fair," but instead, Paul found encouragement in it because it had provided an opportunity for the gospel to be shared with others in the Roman ranks. Even though this bad thing is happening to Paul, he encourages the Philippians that God is actually using this tough time for God's good.

Most of the time we are quick to rush out of the difficult times we face in life, which makes sense because it's hard. But instead of only looking for a way out of the situation, what if we took time to seek God and His purposes for these trials in our lives. Look for ways that God may be using your trial for others to hear about Christ, or to encourage other Christians in their faith, or for you to be a witness to God's faithfulness. How is God using your trials for His good?

6.	Have you ever had any difficult experiences that turned out to be good in the end? What good did you see God bring from it? If you don't, have you seen God work through other people's difficult experiences?

7. What attitudes and perspectives do we have to have in order to view our most difficult times as opportunities for the gospel and for God's glory?

Day 3

TODAY'S THEME: WATCHING YOU

Read Philippians 1:14

Paul isn't just joyful because the gospel is being made known throughout the ranks of the Romans because of his imprisonment, but he is also joyful because it has encouraged other Christians to be bold for their faith and led them to speak out in defense of the gospel as well!

Have you ever watched a movie where the main character (or group of characters) has to overcome tremendous odds? Maybe they had to defeat a powerful enemy, beat a very talented opponent, or find a way to triumph over difficult circumstances. You can probably think of a story like that right now. How did it make you feel as you watched it? More than likely, you felt moved and motivated to work harder or to face your difficulties with a new passion. We have a way of being empowered by the strength of others around us as we watch them rise up in times of great adversity.

That's exactly what Paul is saying is happening with Christians who are hearing and watching him endure these hardships for the sake of the gospel. He says that other Christians have become confident in the Lord through his imprisonment and have become more bold in sharing the gospel. You always have people watching you—friends, family, kids you babysit, peers at school, teachers.... Lots of people! The way you live your life can serve as an encouragement for people to seek the Lord in greater ways and find new confidence in Him, or it can show other people the opposite. How will you rise up in your moments of adversity and trial?

8.	When have you been motivated by the story of someone else staying strong or rising up in the face of great adversity? Did it lead you to live any differently as a result, even if for just a few days?

9. How can your faith serve as a blessing and encouragement to other Christians around you right now? What changes may need to be made for that influence to grow?

Day 4

TODAY'S THEME: HOW DO YOU LIKE ME NOW?

Read Philippians 1:5-17

People can do the right thing for the right reasons, and people can do the right thing for the wrong reasons. Paul tells the Philippians that there are two reasons some people are preaching the gospel about Jesus: either out of selfishness or out of love.

Sometimes people will do good things for the wrong reasons. I bet even you've done it! Maybe you helped set up tables and chairs at church one time because you wanted other people to think you were a really great person or you wanted the girls to think you were strong. (We all know it happens, guys). Maybe you invited that one person to your party to save face with other people. Maybe you shared something super "Christian" in a small group discussion one time so that you looked more spiritual than the other people around you. Whatever it may be, more than likely we've all done it, and people continue to do it all the time.

In Paul's case, there were people who were using his imprisonment for their own gain or selfish ambition, as if in some ways to say, "Hey Paul, look at us! We are out here preaching about Jesus FREELY while you're in prison. HAHAHAHA!" Who knows? But at the end of the day, Paul still rejoiced because even though some people were telling others about Jesus for the wrong reasons, they were still telling people about Jesus and that's all that mattered—that people would hear about Jesus Christ and the good news that He came to save us from our sins!
